- They smell good
- They absorb and hold moisture which is so critical to the compost pile
- Though many believe them to be acidic, used grounds are essentially neutral and composting them with other materials will buffer any minor residual acidity
- With a C/N ratio about 20:1, they are one of the few sources of nitrogen that is widely available year-round to people in urban and suburban areas
- They are easily stored for days in a closed plastic bag
- They are free
- Earthworms love them

HOW TO USE:

- Use them in compost piles and/or worm bins, added directly to the soil, or as mulch
- Sprinkle used grounds around plants before rain or watering, for a slow release of nitrogen
- Try to keep the coffee/compost ratio to about 1:4 for optimal use in composting

- This is the papery husk that covers the dried green bean and is separated from the bean during the roasting process
- It is not acidic in nature
- They are available in large quantities

HOW TO USE:

- It is perfectly safe to use it just about anywhere you need organic material
- Use it in the compost bin, spread it as mulch, or work it directly into the soil

- Cut them open and use as biodegradable weed cloth, laying them on top of your mulch and cut holes to plant through
- Use for carrying mulch or garden debris
